Nicotrol Inhaler® (\$2.00 or \$4.00 co-pay)

Nicotrol NS® (\$2.00 or \$4.00 co-pay)

Zyban® (\$2.00 or \$4.00 co-pay)

The following OTC generic products are covered (with a prescription), if from a participating manufacturer:

Nicotine Gum (\$1.00 co-pay)

Nicorelief Gum (\$1.00 co-pay)

Nicotine Patches (\$1.00 co-pay)
